



1 – The Meadow – The Beginning

The beginning of the journey. It represents new beginnings, starting a new chapter, hopefulness, meditation, clarity, and peace of mind. White altar candle.

2 – Archangel Sandalphon – Music

The healing power of music. If the querent is not themselves a musician, this card is an invitation to incorporate music more fully into their life and their meditations. Can also symbolize victory.

3 – Cat – Independence

Independent, vigilant, quiet, and watchful. Patience is needed with the passage of time. The pocket watch may signify a male ancestor trying to send a message to the querent.

4 – Archangel Michael – Protection

Protection in all matters, both spiritually and here on Earth. Archangel Michael clears a path in front of the querent to make space for peace of mind after a period of difficulty, healing, and clarity. Red or white altar candle.

5 – Crow – Discernment

The crow cannot see his reflection as he is scrying in the mirror to see his future. This card represents the need for more discernment in a particular situation—an invitation to look more closely to discern the truth in a particular situation.

6 – Dog – Gratitude

A strong gratitude practice is the cornerstone of spirituality and healing. Write down three things each day before bed that you are grateful for. White altar candle.

7 – Lemons – Awareness

Symbolizes both the light and dark of the number 7 in numerology, as well the importance of bringing heightened awareness to a particular situation. Can also symbolize a female ancestor trying to connect with the querent. Archangel Jophiel appears here to help declutter emotions.

8 – Hummingbird – Miracle

This card comes when the querent may be in need of a miracle or has done the spiritual work of being ready to manifest one. White or purple altar candle.

9 – Sage – Cleansing

When the querent pulls this card, they will know they need to perform a house or personal energy clearing. Archangel Raziel appears here to assist with past lives, all-knowing, and

spiritual clearing. Burning sage or other herbs, rosewater, or sprig of rosemary in a spray bottle to clear a space along with intention and mantra.

10 – Tree – Journey

The start of every shamanic journey to the other realms, where we take the candle that has been left for us inside the door and travel down deep into the tree to seek guidance from our guides, ancestors, and helping and compassionate spirits. White altar candle.

11 – Archangel Azrael – Connection

The Egret appears here flying through the cypress trees to symbolize connection with the Other Side, mediumship, connection with ancestors, and the master angel number healing power of 11. If the querent is not themselves a medium, this card symbolizes their heightened connection to Spirit. White or purple altar candle.

12 – Cooper's Hawk – Message

When a querent pulls this card, they know that an important message is coming to them through signs. Watch for the synchronicities and wait. Yellow altar candle.

13 – Spirit Guide – Mentorship

At the top of the stairs, your Spirit Guide waits to meet you. The number 13, the Goddess Number, brings in a vibration of love and healing to your search. If the querent does not yet have a Spirit Guide, they should ask for signs and messages in dreams and meditations. White altar candle.

14 – Butterfly – Transformation

Transformation, rebirth, and renewal. Remember that it takes the butterfly quite awhile to complete their process of transformation—be firm but gentle with yourself as you transform. Orange or yellow altar candle.

15 – Bee – Community

The importance of finding community, connecting with others to heal, and finding/remembering life's sweetness. Yellow or orange altar candle.

16 – Owl – Premonition

Owls bring messages and possible warnings about the near future. If the querent has an owl sighting in Nature, this message is even more direct. Remember that owls also symbolize self-knowledge and clarity of mind.

17 – Deer – Love

Symbolizing all types of love, especially love of self and love of family. This card appears as a reminder to take practices of self-love and self-care seriously at this time. Archangel Raguel arrives to assist with healing communication in relationships. Pink altar candle.

18 – Bear – Patience

The Bear card represents the need for patient strength in all matters. Can also represent a protecting male guardian spirit on the Other Side.

19 – Whale – Family

When the querent pulls this card, they are serving or will be serving a strong caregiving role in some way (to a human, an animal, a community, etc.) This card can also symbolize a new pregnancy or adoption. Pink altar candle.

20 – Archangel Gabriel – Creativity

Archangel Gabriel arrives to bless creative projects, particularly writing. Also assists with fertility.

21– Snawfus – Blessing

A snawfus is a magical creature in Ozark folklore who bestows blessings. When this beautiful white deer with a crown of flowers comes to you, make a wish, and it is said that this wish will come true. White or purple altar candle.

22 – Dragonfly – Sign from Spirit

When a querent pulls this card, they know that a loved one is trying to contact them from the Other Side. The master angel number 22 brings a healing vibration of connection with loved ones who have passed. White altar candle.

23 – Fish – Flow

A reminder to live in a state of flow. If everything is feeling like a struggle, this card will be pulled by the querent to represent the need to pause, regroup, and start over. Green or orange altar candle.

24 – Wolf – Dreams

The wisdom that comes to us in dreams is represented by the black wolf. Wolves are a matrilineal society that practices strength, patience, power, family, and discernment. Start a dream journal if your dreams are becoming more powerful. Black or white altar candle.

25 – Lion – Strength

The Lion represents personal strength and courage. A reminder that all the querent has endured has given them the strength they need to continue moving forward in their lives. Yellow or red altar candle.

26 – Otter – Play

A reminder of the importance of incorporating childlike play into the querent's life. Remember that playing is the same vibrational frequency as praying.

27 – Cheetah – Achievement

Climbing to a higher perspective, the Cheetah is now able to transcend struggle and to clearly see all the blessings that lie in front of her. Purple, orange, yellow, or white altar candle.

28 – Snake – Change

Change is coming. The snake represents regeneration as well as change. Archangel Jeremiel arrives to assist with life review and encouraging positive change.

29 – Sun – Certainty

The sun card comes when the querent has gained certainty, truth, or clarity on a matter. Represented by masculinity/Gold.

30 – Moon – Fluidity

The moon card represents fluidity, uncertainty, or the need to live in the in-between. Represented by femininity/Silver. Archangel Haniel assists here with natural healing.

31 – Horse – Heart

The horse represents the need for heart healing. This card will appear when the querent needs assistance moving forward in their lives. Can also represent the need for creating stronger boundaries in interpersonal relationships. Green or white altar candle.

32 – Earth – Grounding

This card arrives when a reminder is needed to ground the querent's energy and spend more time working on healing their physical body and mind/body/spirit connection through movement and immersion in Nature. Green or brown altar candle.

33 – Crossroads – Decision

A decision must be made. The master angel number 33 assists with supporting the querent as they face this difficult choice. White, black, or red altar candle.

34 – Mountain – Obstacle

The querent is about to face or is facing an obstacle or challenge. The pink flowers on the side of the mountain represent love, support, and assistance. White or pink altar candle.

35 – Door – Closure

An end is near, or there is a need to create closure on a matter. Black or white altar candle.

36 – Archangel Raphael – Physical Healing

Archangel Raphael arrives to help with physical healing. Raphael can also assist with emotional healing, as well as travel. Remember to give all angels permission to assist more directly. Green or yellow altar candle.

37 – Blue Lake – Emotional Healing

Archangels Raphael and Zadkiel appear here to assist with emotional healing, low energy, mental support, and clarity. The dragonflies by the healing blue lake represent support from the querent's ancestors. Blue altar candle.

38 – Fire – Releasing

The power of fire to transform, release, and let go. Ask the fire to help burn and cleanse away what should be let go of. Archangel Nathaniel raises the vibration of the other angels every time he is near. Black, yellow, or orange altar candle.

39 – Black Jaguar – Magic

The Black Jaguar represents a deepening connection to Spirit, magic, shamanism, and shadow work. Black or white altar candle.

40 – Archangel Metatron – Chakra Balancing

The need for knowledge, study, and research. Also represents a message to work on chakra balancing in the querent's individual physical/spiritual practices.

41 – Mountain Temple – Manifestation

At the foot of the mountain is a temple that houses an altar. Journey to this mountain temple to help with manifesting what the querent wants to bring into their lives. Archangel Uriel arrives to assist with divination. White or purple altar candle. If the querent has not yet made an altar in their home, this is a strong message to do so.

42 – Rose and Fox – Partnership

Romantic love. A relationship or connection is on its way or an existing connection is deepening. Archangel Chamuel assists with love, loving life, and helping to connect the querent with the opportunities they are meant for. Pink or red altar candle.

43 – Marigolds – Abundance

In many cultures, from India to Mexico, marigolds represent abundance and deep connection to ancestors. Archangel Ariel arrives here to bless the querent with assistance in financial abundance, in particular. Abundance is on its way. Green altar candle.

44 – Angel Number – Synchronicity

This card arrives when the querent has been hard at work, deepening their spiritual practice. Synchronicities are everywhere, as are repeating numbers. This card represents ascension. White, purple, or blue altar candle.

45 – First Chakra – Earth

The first chakra's color, red, is symbolized by Earth. When this card is pulled, the querent has the need for more grounding, or there has been a rupture in their stability of family, work, or home. Red altar candle.

46 – Second Chakra – Water

The second chakra's color, orange, is symbolized by Water. When this card is pulled, the querent has the need for balancing the sacral chakra of an interpersonal relationship with another person or their own relationship to their creativity, language, and sexuality. Orange altar candle.

47 – Third Chakra – Fire

The third chakra's color, yellow, is symbolized by Fire. When this card is pulled, the querent should pay closer attention to their relationship with themselves, fulfilling promises, deepening willpower, and strengthening their sense of personal honor and integrity. Yellow altar candle.

48 – Fourth Chakra – Air

The fourth chakra's color, green, is symbolized by Air. When this card is pulled, the querent has a need for heart healing, either in a specific physical sense or emotionally/spiritually. Can also represent a need for a deeper connection to Nature. Green altar candle.

49 – Fifth Chakra – Sound

The fifth chakra's color, blue, is symbolized by Sound. When this card is pulled, the querent has a need to strengthen their voice, speaking up for themselves, and being assertive. Blue altar candle to assist with finding/reconnecting with their voice, as well as angel healing.

50 – Sixth Chakra – Intuition

The sixth chakra's color, purple, represents intuition, deepening psychic abilities, and intuitive connections to Spirit. Purple altar candle.
